## Flick Fest (Carrom) Rules

- Player must report 30 minutes before allotted time.
- All Participants must carry their College IDs and Government IDs for registration.
- The tournament will follow a knockout format.
- Players are requested to bring their own striker, if they have one available.
- A toss will decide who breaks first. The winner of the toss chooses either: To break, or To allow the opponent to break.
- The Referee decision will be final.
- Powder will be allowed only with referee's permission and in moderation.
- The Queen can be pocketed only after the player has pocketed at least one of their own coins and must be covered by pocketing another coin of their colour immediately after.
- 1 point for each coin and 3 points for queen if pocketed and covered.
- If a player pockets the striker, it will be considered a foul, and one of their pocketed coins will be returned to the board as a penalty.
- If a player takes a strike before all the coins on the board have come to rest, the shot will be declared invalid, and it will count as a foul.
- If the striker is not placed correctly, touching both the baseline and the arrow properly before striking, it will result in a foul.
- If the striker jumps off the board during play, it will be considered a foul, and the turn will pass to the opponent.
- If a player uses both hands while striking, it will be counted as a foul since only one hand is allowed during play.
- Players are expected to maintain discipline and fair play throughout the event. Any misconduct may lead to immediate disqualification and the opponent will go ahead of that round.

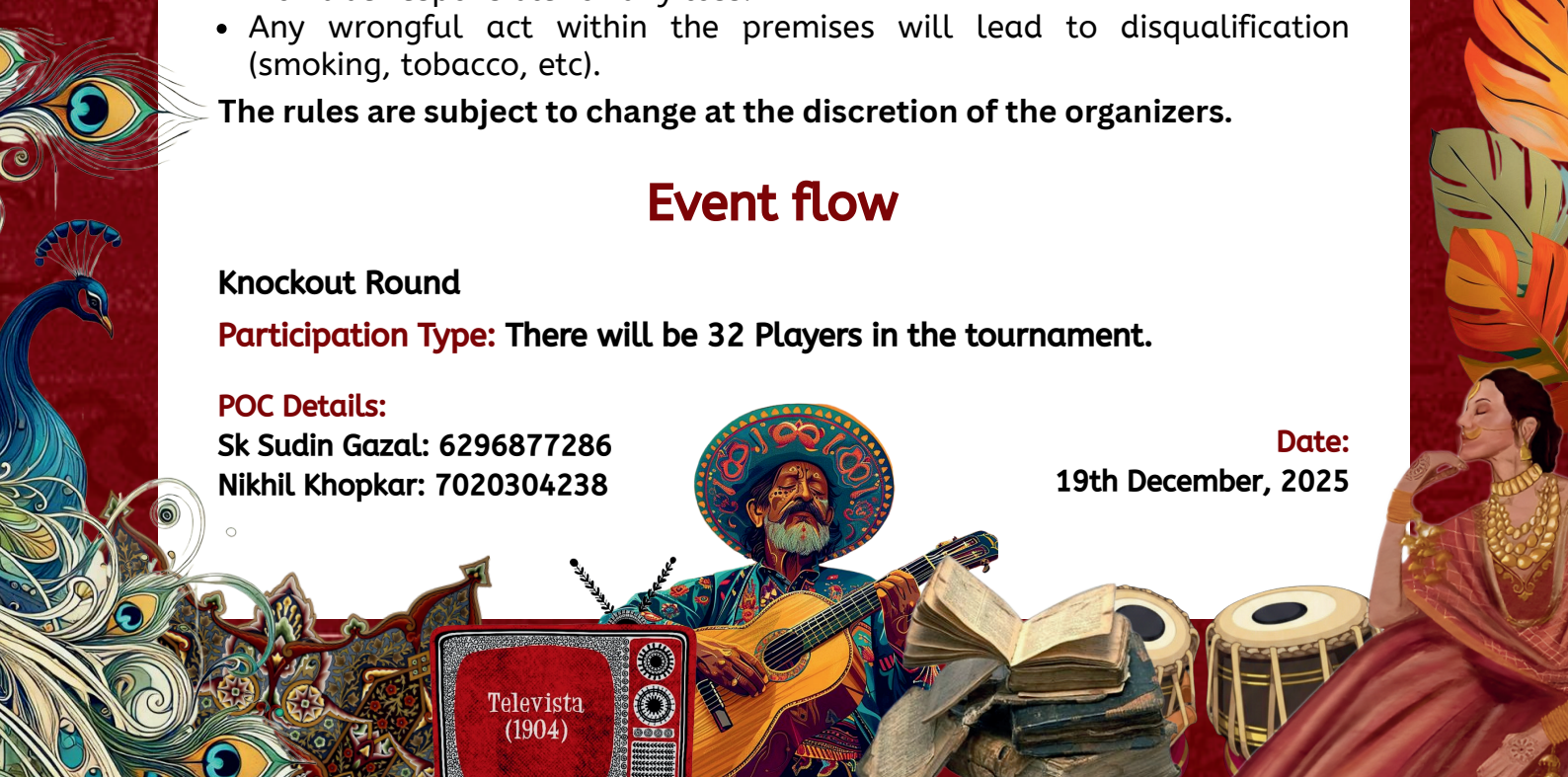

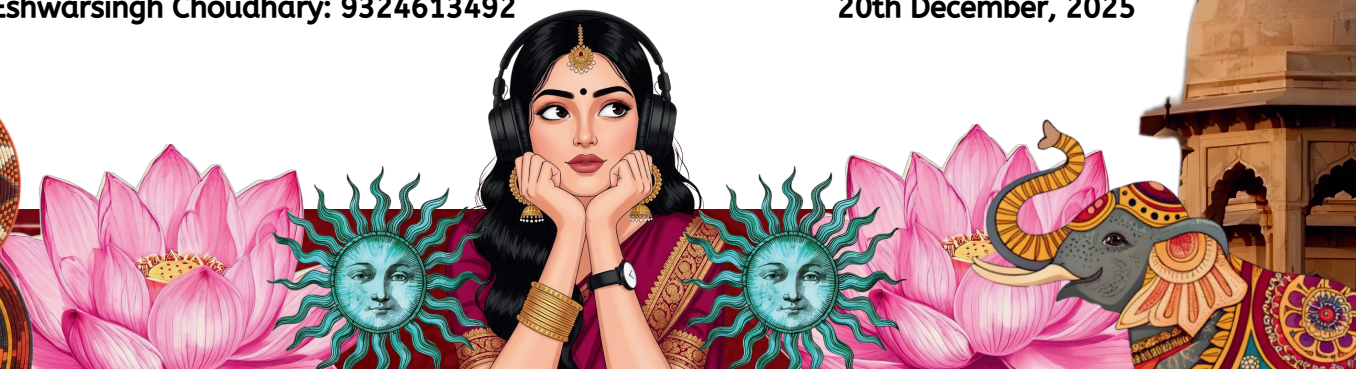

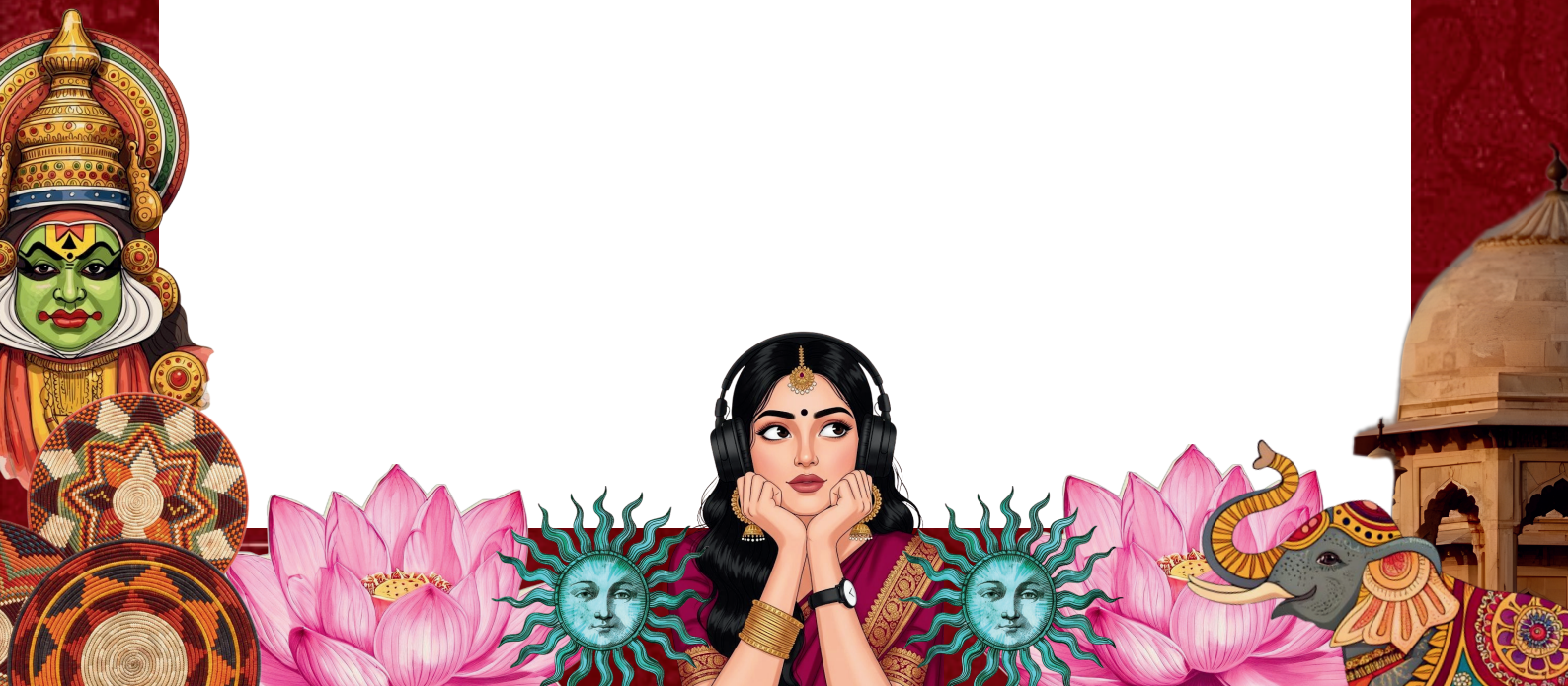
